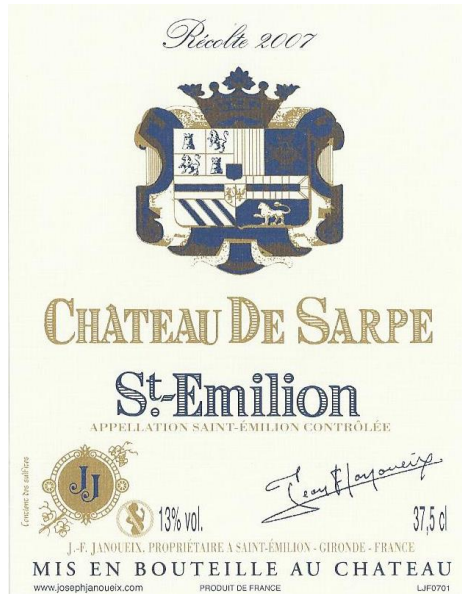


Joseph JANOUUEIX



CHATEAU DE SARPE

AOC Saint-Emilion

“One of the most ancient and renown terroir of St Emilion”

Appellation : Saint-Emilion

Proprietor : Jean-François Janoueix in 1969

Vineyard area : 2,43 hectares

Production : 15 800 bottles

Grapes : 70% Merlot, 30% Cabernet franc

Owner of six growths in Saint-Emilion and three in Pomerol, the Janoueix family is a well established producer in the Libournais.

Well located on a superb plateau of limestone between two classified growths, (among which Haut Sarpe, that belongs to the family) this vineyard overlooks the medieval city of Saint-Emilion, just distant of 600m.

Made of 70% merlot and 30% cabernet franc, the 2007 displays a slightly evolved garnet colour. Discreet scents of cherries and candied fruits get along with round tannins on the palate ending on notes of forest-floor and a hint of acidity. Overall it is a pleasant and balance wine ready to drink now.
