Similar to the neighbouring soil of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, it consists on pebbles which store heat in the daytime and restore it to the vinestocks in the night-time.

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VINIFICATION/AGING

- Traditional vinification in stainless steel tanks
 - An average two week vatting time
 - Aging of 12 months in concrete tanks
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CHARACTER

This Côtes-du-Rhône, rich and elegant, combines a good structure with delicacy. Red-berry aromas prevail in the smell and during the tasting.

ACCOMPANIMENT

This wine goes well with all sorts of meat as well as cheese
