SOIL

Similar to the neighbouring soil of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, it consists on pebbles which store heat in the daytime and restore it to the vinestocks in the night-time. Sandy-red-clay subsoil.

GRAPE VARIETIES

• 60% Grenache • 40% Syrah

VINIFICATION/AGING

- Traditional vinification in stainless steel tanks
- An average two weeks vatting time
- Aging of 12 month in concrete tanks

CHARACTER

This Côtes-du-Rhône Villages is characterised by very strong aromas of red fruits and liquorice. It combines the freshness of the Côtes-du-Rhône and the structure of a Châteauneuf-du-Pape.

ACCOMPANIMENT

Fruity and full-bodied, this wine goes well with grilled or roasted meats flavoured with thyme and rosemary. It will enhance its aromas of Provençal herbs.
