# Les Volcans

## *AOP Coteaux du Languedoc - Pezenas*

This red wine is from a selection of the oldest wines in the village of Royat. Overlooking the volcano of St Marthele Prieuré Royat du Château Cassan. There are single vineyards with different grapes varieties on the same very specific terroir: volcanic lava and gravels basalt. This wine highlights the exceptional quality of the old vineyards of Languedoc, noble and authentic.

Ruby to garnet with a remarkable density. Red berries, blackberries, cassis with some delicate notes of kirsch. There is also violet flowers, pepper and garrigue. Background and retro-olfaction bring aromas of licorice and oak from ageing in barrels for 7 months. We find a clean tannic support combining Syrah and Mourvèdre, establishing a prefect harmony with Grenache and Carignan. The palate is powerful but the tannic structure is rounded, showing a potential of ageing of 5 to 8 years. This Mourvèdre, aged 25 years old, is the first to be seen in Gabian village, sitting next to 1956 Carignan and 1962 Syrah!
