



Le Loup dans la Bergerie Rouge

This wine is a blend of wines sourced from young Hortus vineyards and rigorously selected wines from surrounding winegrowers

Appellation: Vin de Pays Saint Guilhem Le Désert

Grapes: Syrah, Grenache

Climatic Conditions: Mediterranean, humid and cool

Yield: 35 to 45 hl/ha according to the vintage

Terroir: Brown soils lying on coarse alluvium from the Quaternary, on marly calcareous parent rock or on scree formed with limestone fragments under the cliff. Sub-horizontal slope. Altitude 120m. Intermediate exposure.

Vinification: Destemmed and crushed harvest, vatting for 15 to 20 days.

Ageing: 6 to 8 months in stainless steel vats.

Tasting Notes: Ruby color with purple highlights. Seductive nose, aromas of red fruits (strawberry, cherry, raspberry) and spices (licorice). Round, supple and lively mouth. Fleshy palate of fruits and spices, fine tannins with a mouth-watering finish.
