Cuvée MAYNE DU CROS 2014
AOC Graves Blanc



Well known property belonging to the Famille Boyer since 1971. Catherine Boyer runs this quality terroir with a great passion. Christophe Blanchet as vineyard manager and Henri Boyer, her brother, as oenologist.

Mayne du Cros is a special cuvee of the Château Haut-Mayne located in Cérons.

GENERAL TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Terroir:

The vineyard of Château Haut-Mayne grows on the gravel plots left bank of the Garonne River, 35 km South of Bordeaux.

Rounded and polished gravel is found on the surface. The substratum is calcareous and sandy soils unite the whole.

Size of the vineyard : 15 ha

A high planting density : 5500 vines/hectare.

Average age of the vines : 32 years

Production:

Average yield : 49hl / ha

Volume : 6000 bottles

Vinification and maceration :

- Cold pre-fermentation Maceration (one week).
- Alcoholic fermentation in barrels.
- Barrel ageing : 9 months in French oak (50% new oak).

TECHNICAL FEATURES OF THE 2014 VINTAGE

Harvest : from August 28th

Final alcohol content : 12,5 % alc. by volume

Blending 2014:

50% Sauvignon Blanc; 50% Sémillon

Tasting notes:

Very pale color with green tints.

Tight nose, mint and white flowers. Oak is very present but judiciously placed in the background. The palate shows dry lemon, citrus and toasted bread and mix of citrus freshness.
