Mayne du Cros is a special barrel cuvee of the Château Haut-Mayne located in Cérons.

GENERAL TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Terroir:

The vineyard of Château Haut-Mayne grows on the gravel plots left bank of the Garonne River, 35 km South of Bordeaux.

Rounded and polished gravel is found on the surface. The substratum is calcareous and sandy soils unite the whole.

Size of the vineyard : 15 ha

A high planting density : 5500 vines/hectare.

Average age of the vines : 45 years

Production:

Average yield : 47hl / ha

Vinification and maceration :

- Hard selection on table sorting.
- Quick Cold pre-fermentation Maceration
- Quick Post-fermentation Maceration
- Barrel ageing in French oak, 12 months (30% new oak).

TECHNICAL FEATURES OF THE 2014 VINTAGE

Harvest : from September 18th

Final alcohol content : 13.5 % alc. by volume

Blending 2014:

30% Cabernet-Sauvignon ; 10% Cabernet-Franc ; 60% Merlot

Tasting notes:

Concentration of ripe cabernet fruits.

Good acid nicely balanced with blackberries aromas, game like wildboo. Soft tannins.

This vintage has produced a soft and fruity vintage.
