SOIL

Similar to the neighbouring soil of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, it consists on pebbles which store heat in the daytime and restore it to the vinestocks in the night-time.

Red clay in the subsoil.

GRAPE VARIETIES

• 65 % Grenache Noir • 15 % Syrah • 12 % Carignan
• 5 % Cinsault • 2 % Counoise • 1 % Mourvèdre

VINIFICATION / AGING

- Traditional vinification in stainless-steel tanks
- An average two weeks vatting time
- Aging of 12 months in concrete tanks

CHARACTER

This Côtes du Rhône, rich and elegant, combines a good structure with delicacy.

Red-berry aromas prevail in the smell and during the tasting.

Potential of aging: 5 to 8 years

ACCOMPANIMENT

This wine goes well with all sorts of meats as well as cheese.
