Around 300.000 bottles (25.000 cases)

#### SOIL

Similar to the neighbouring soil of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, it consists on pebbles which store heat in the daytime and restore it to the vinestocks in the night-time. Red clay in the subsoil.

#### **GRAPE VARIETIES**

- 65 % Grenache Noir 15 % Syrah 12 % Carignan
- 5 % Cinsault 2 % Counoise 1 % Mourvèdre

#### VINIFICATION / AGING

- Traditional vinification in stainsless-steel tanks
- · An average two weeks vatting time
- Aging of 12 months in concrete tanks

#### **CHARACTER**

This Côtes du Rhône, rich and elegant, combines a good structure with delicacy.

Red-berry aromas prevail in the smell and during the tasting. Potential of aging: 5 to 8 years

#### **ACCOMPANIMENT**

This wine goes well with all sorts of meats as well as cheese.
